

IMPORTANT NOTICE

SCMA Members' Insurance Trust
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Women's Health and Cancer Act of 1998

On October 21, 1998, Congress enacted the Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998. This notice explains some important provisions of the Act. Please review this information carefully.

As specified in the Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998, a MIT plan participant or beneficiary who elects breast reconstruction in connection with a mastectomy also will be covered for:

- ▷ Reconstruction of the breast on which the mastectomy was performed.
- ▷ Surgery and reconstruction of the other breast to produce a symmetrical appearance; and
- ▷ Prostheses and treatment of physical complications at all stages of the mastectomy, including lymphedemas.

The coverage will be provided in a manner determined in consultation with the attending physician and patient.

Deductibles and coinsurance established for other benefits under your plan may apply to these reconstructive surgery benefits.

This plan is in compliance with The Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998.
